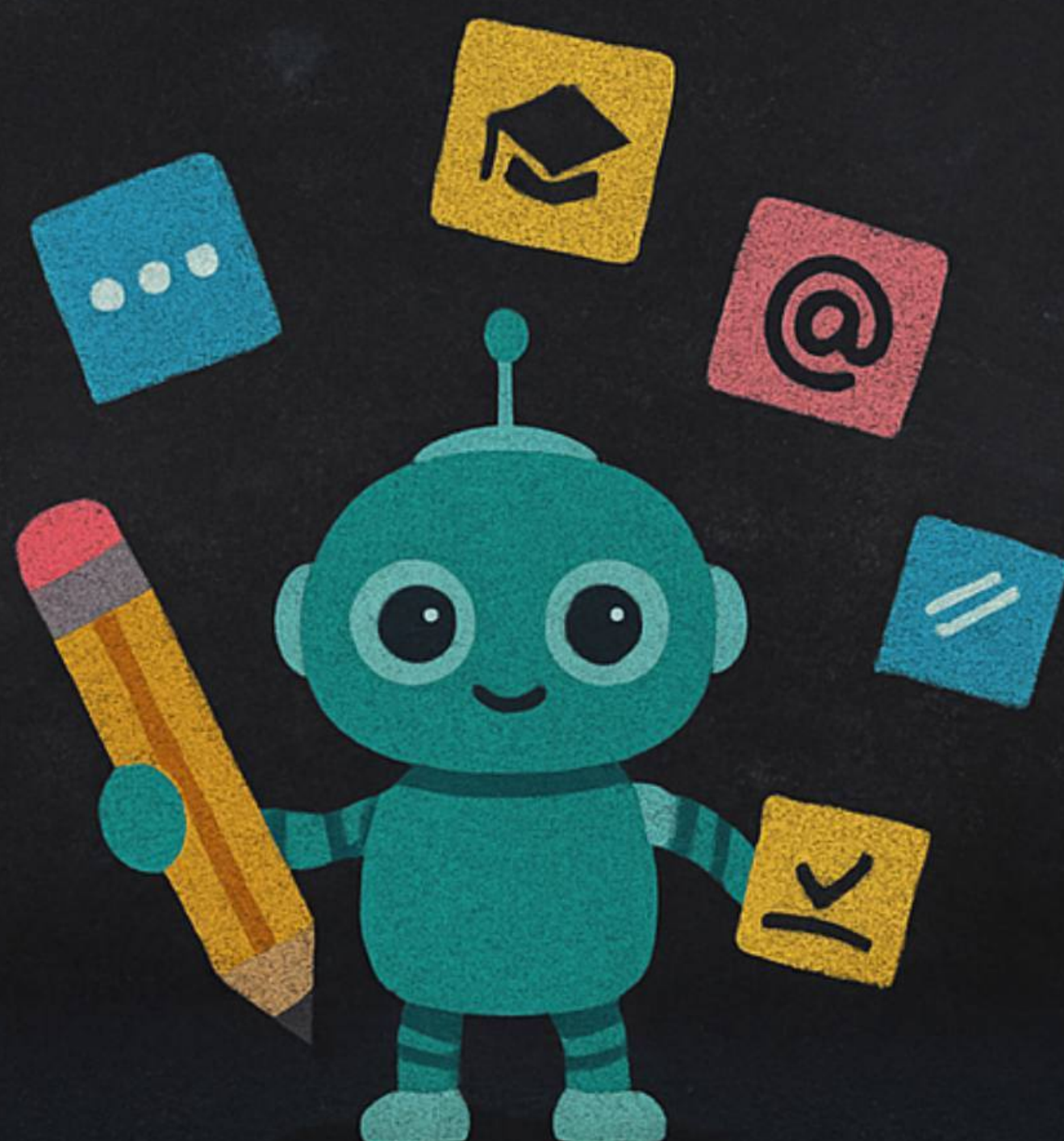

- Test all three models for best output.

Core Prompt Starters (1–5)



1	Act as a (grade) teacher and create a lesson outline on (topic).
2	Rewrite this text at a [reading level] with key terms bolded.
3	Generate 5 formative assessment questions for [objective].
4	Summarize these class notes in bullet points.
5	Provide 3 differentiated activity ideas for [concept].

Classroom Productivity Prompts (1–5)

1. Lesson-Plan
Skeleton

Generate a multimedia 5-day lesson-plan scaffold on [topic] with suggested image prompts for each day.

2. Substitute
Teacher Plan

Write a detailed sub plan for today’s math class covering fractions with step-by-step activities.

3. PD Meeting
Agenda

Design a slide-friendly PD agenda with suggested slide headings, discussion questions, and image prompts.

4. Daily Classroom
Checklist

Pull standard morning routines and create a priority-ranked checklist that updates with today’s schedule.

5. Parent Contact Log

Create a table template to track parent contacts, including date, topic discussed, and next-step follow-up.

ChatGPT: “As a 7th-grade social studies teacher, connect today’s lesson on ancient trade routes to modern global supply chains, citing two recent news stories and including discussion questions.”

7. Student Reflection
& Metacognition

Gemini: “Design a visual reflection template with icons for ‘What I Tried,’ ‘What Worked,’ and ‘What I’ll Try Next,’ plus space for an image or doodle per section.”

8. Family
Engagement

ChatGPT: “Draft a friendly weekly update email for families summarizing student highlights in reading, including one student quote and a recommended book of the week.”

9. Cross-Curricular
Hooks

Grok: “Using current solar energy market data, create a cross-curricular case study prompt where students propose improvements to solar panel design and draft an investor pitch.”

10. Current Events
Tie-Ins

Grok: “Pull the latest space mission data and craft a real-time data interpretation prompt: ‘Analyze these telemetry charts and explain any anomalies.’”

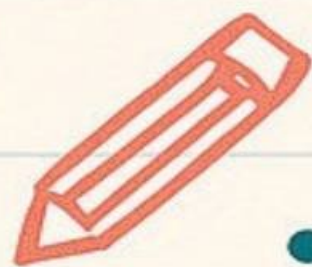

Prompt Audit Checklist

Before using any AI-generated prompt in your classroom, quickly verify:

- 1. Clarity** Is the prompt specific and easy to understand?
- 2. Alignment** Does it match your lesson objective or standard?
- 3. Inclusivity** Are examples and language free of bias and stereotypes?
- 4. Accuracy** Have you fact-checked any data or references.
